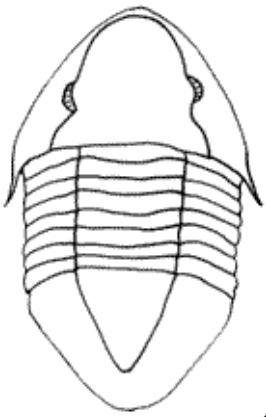

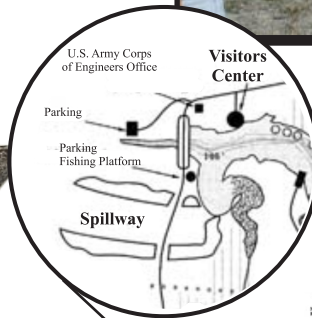

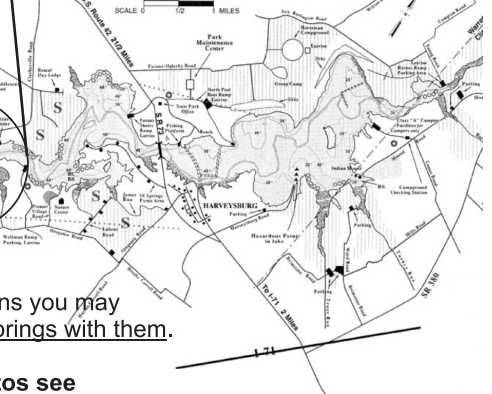

**What To Bring:** Plan to prepare for the day's heat by bring the following; sun screen, hats, water, bug spray, and perhaps some cardboard to kneel on as you look. We'll drive back from where we hunt the fossils to the Visitor Center and have lunch together at an enclosure we have reserved. During the noon lunch (folding chairs welcome, but not needed) we'll begin the time of sharing and when that's finished, we're back to the fossil hunt! **NOTE: Be at the visitor center for the 9:30 AM required orientation.**

Remember we hunt rain or shine! No tools allowed to be used, but you don't need them anyway.
